BACK TO BEAUTY SCHOOL **-Superdrug brings everything needed to get the St Trinian's look -**

Opt for cheek tint to give the natural glow achieved by standing in the playground in the cold at break time, we recommend FAMOUS lip and cheek tint (£10), keeping it natural and popping it on the lips so that the two match. Every rebellious girl at school could never wear enough eyeliner, for a smooth glide choose GOSH velvet touch eyeliner in black (£6.49) and it can be used to add some extra freckles too!

True mascara in black will complete the look and it can be bought using pocket money too at only £1.95.

For those feeling extra adventurous there are GOSH metallic effect powders, available in over 20 colours to add some extra shimmer.

Don't forget some chipped nail polish – to achieve the effect apply one coat of Barry M Nail Paint (£2.95) in a bright shade, wait for it to dry before getting comfy with a nail file to scuff up the edges.

For the hair make sure it is smooth and glossy by spraying over Expertise anti frizz and shine mist (£2.99) then separate using a mirror and a narrow tooth comb (99p) to ensure the parting is straight and the hair evenly split. Hold back half the hair using Kirby grips (£1.49) and weave a loose flat braid, tie securely with True Spirit hair elastics (£1.29) and then repeat on the other side.
